

Dear CART Students & Families,

We are reaching out to you regarding CART's reopening plan.

With Clovis Unified School District's recent announcement that all secondary students choosing in person instruction will be phased back in during the week of February 22<sup>nd</sup> and Fresno Unified School District's announcement that they will continue to promote a gradual return of students to in-person instruction, CART is in a unique position between the two school districts. CART also needs to make sure we provide an equitable opportunity for all CART students to return to some form of in-person instruction.

There is no absolute right way for us to proceed, but we have continued to work diligently as a team on site and with both districts to come up with a compromise, which will allow for at least some in-person learning time for all of our students.

- **CART students will return for in person learning starting March 9 and 10.**
  - Half of our students will attend on Tuesdays and the other half will attend on Wednesdays.
  - Mondays, Thursdays and Fridays will remain with all virtual instruction until further notice.
  - Students and families will be notified by February 26 which day, Tuesday or Wednesday, that they are assigned to come to CART in person and bus schedules will also be available by the end of February.

CART will continue to work with both districts and each school site to accommodate students' needs with their home school schedules and CART's plan. Thank you for your patience and support during this time of transition.
